Pastor's Letter

They were all filled with the Holy Spirit.
Acts 2:4

The Holy Spirit distributes many and diverse gifts among us. The Spirit is persistent in both sharing these gifts and inspiring us to make use of them. St. John tells us that Jesus first breathed the Holy Spirit upon those gathered in the upper room when he appeared to them on Easter. However, Luke tells us that their hesitancy and fear remained, especially after Jesus ascended into the heavens. Pentecost transformed the apostles and fueled their mission to bring the message of Jesus to the world.

We inherit that same mission. We may not serve as missionaries to foreign lands or to those who have never heard of Jesus. Nonetheless, we are called to view everything in our life as a gift from God given to us so that we can share with others. That is the heart of stewardship.

Stewardship is a word that has become more familiar to Catholics in recent years. We dedicate some of our time, we share some of our talents, and we offer some of our material treasure to serve our mission to bring Christ to others. **Stewardship of time** is a commitment to daily prayer and to gathering at least weekly for Eucharist. **Stewardship of talent** is living our specific vocation as spouses, parents, teachers, community leaders, voices for social justice, and ministers of the parish or larger Church. **Stewardship of treasure** provides the material resources to fund the people and materials on which the parish, the larger Church, and various charities rely.

I have been awed by the generosity of parishioners who continue to make so much possible. Your current sacrifices have brought us back to a balanced budget. That is a great blessing.

We are pleased to announce that registration for Summer 2025 is now open. As you may know from previous announcements, SFX is partnering again with Grace Lutheran for this summer's VBS program. The VBS program will run June 23-27 (Monday-Friday) from 9:00am-12:00 noon. VBS is open to children aged 4 through 4th grade. 5th and 6th graders can participate as members of a "service crew" that will spend the week organizing and conducting a series of service projects.

The little ones will attend VBS at Grace Lutheran. The service crew will be based at SFX school this year. Due to space constraints attendance will be capped at 150 for the little ones and 30 for the service crew so please register early.

A successful VBS program is not possible without the help of parent, teen and middle school volunteers. Also for teens and middle schoolers, you do not have to have a sibling in VBS in order to participate and you can earn service hours! In particular we need adult and teen volunteers to support the service crew.






