Pastor's Letter

Dear friends in Christ,

Next week, from June 15-18, the priests of the Archdiocese of Chicago will gather together for our convocation: a few days dedicated to prayer, conferences, fraternity and rest. It's a time to step away briefly from the ordinary rhythms of parish life in order to reconnect with brother priests, deepen our spiritual lives and return renewed for ministry.

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus looks on the crowds with compassion and sends his disciples out on mission. Elsewhere in the Gospel, however, Jesus also speaks these important words to his disciples: "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while" (Mark 6:31). Jesus understands something essential about human life and discipleship: periods of work and service must be balanced by moments of rest and refreshment. Even those engaged in the Lord's work need time to pray, reflect and be restored.

One of the things I've come to appreciate about St. Francis Xavier is that this is truly a work-hard, play-hard parish. People here are generous, energetic and deeply committed. We work hard and accomplish wonderful things together, but we also understand the importance of stepping back to enjoy family and friends, gather around the table, spend time outdoors, enjoy sports, share good food, and appreciate the gift of summer. That rhythm of effort and renewal is not simply practical; it's deeply biblical.

As our priests gather next week, please keep us in your prayers. May this time of renewal strengthen us for the work of proclaiming the Gospel and serving God's people. May each of us remember the wisdom of Jesus: sometimes one of the holiest things we can do is to pause, rest and receive again the goodness of the Lord.
