Pastor's Letter

"Now I know for certain that the Lord sent his angel and rescued me."
Acts 12:11

You, the people of Saint Francis Xavier Parish, have been the angel of God to me at two key points in my priesthood. The first was in 1990, when I was returning to active ministry after a six-year leave of absence during which I experienced life in the corporate world. I arrived with the blessing of Cardinal Joseph Bernardin and a deep faith that priesthood was indeed God's path for me. The parish was celebrating its 100th anniversary. Many of you who are here now were not yet born; many others have gone on to what awaits us in the kingdom. Those of you who were here welcomed, taught, and formed me as I fell in love with priesthood for the second time in my life. I served briefly under Fr. Dan Coughlin and then under Fr. Bill Stenzel while living with our Pastor Emeritus, Fr. Pierce Joyce. I was invited into the process of the renovation of our worship space; I saw the parish elementary school come to life under the guidance of Barbara Snopek; and I served at the side of many dedicated lay and religious leaders.

You, the people of Saint Francis Xavier, became the angel of God to me again in 2015. I had stepped away from an experience as pastor that had left me questioning whether I would ever again serve in that capacity. The parish was celebrating its 125th anniversary. Fr. John Hoffman welcomed me with the hope that I would consider becoming pastor when he retired. Many of you had grown a bit older with me; many parents were now grandparents and the children in the elementary school were your grandchildren. I witnessed the building of a new space that literally united the Education Building and the church. I accepted the invitation to become the tenth pastor of this parish, and you once again welcomed, taught, and formed me as I fell in love with pastoring a faith community for the second time in my life.

We made a great staff even greater with the faith and talents of women and men of various ages whom I now embrace as the best staff with whom I have ever served. We invited and encouraged new lay leadership and some restructuring of the Parish Pastoral Council, School Advisory Board, and Finance Council. We joined with sisters and brothers in the parishes of La Grange and Western Springs to minister to youth, to people seeking to enter the Catholic Church, and to immigrants attempting to establish a home for their families in a new and unfamiliar culture. We journeyed through the COVID years together; then we witnessed our weekend liturgies filling up with young families who bring your toddlers to our worship experience. We have seen the regrowth of both our Elementary School and School of Religious Education with new, energized leadership. We professed our desire to be a community in which all were invited to **Belong**, to grow deeper in what we **Believe**, and to **Be Love** by putting our faith into action through service of people in and beyond our community.

I hope you all know the gift we have received from God as the Parish of Saint Francis Xavier. We have allowed the Holy Spirit to shape and direct us so that our doors would be open to those who seek a home in which to grow in faith and service. Everything I have seen and heard tells me that the Spirit has blessed you with a pastor who will come to love you all, as have I and the pastors with whom I have been blessed to serve and live with in over 15 years as a member of Saint Francis Xavier Parish. God bless you all.
