Pastor's Letter

"Go and <u>make</u> disciples of all nations, baptizing and teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." Matthew 28:19-20

Jesus ascends to the Father and gives the great commission to his disciples – both to those present that day and to all of us who will become his disciples. *Our mission* is to go, to *make disciples*, to baptize, and to teach. It is easy to understand the baptizing and the teaching. One is a set ritual with its own words and symbols; the other is the process of imparting the knowledge from scripture and the life of the Church over 2,000 years. "Go and make disciples" presents us with the deepest challenge as *missionary disciples*.

Baptizing and teaching are the things we do to help those already on a journey with Christ. *Missionary discipleship reaches out to those not yet on the journey with Christ*; it comes from within. It is rooted in a *personal* relationship with Jesus that is deepened and nurtured through prayer. It involves a willingness to share *our stories* of how God has entered *our lives* in both ordinary and extraordinary ways. It expresses an enthusiasm, a joy, and a peace that grows from God's dwelling within us.

The disciples were not yet ready to take on this mission on the day of the Ascension. The fire and breath of the Holy Spirit would literally drive them out to give witness to Jesus. We are challenged to desire what they came to experience: the presence of God so alive in us that we attract others to want to discover what we have found. We make a conscious decision to become a communion: united with those we know and those whom we do not yet know; those with whom we easily agree and those whose views challenge us; those who walk in relatively straight lines and those who wander and explore. This is the Spirit that breathed life into the early church and led to tremendous growth. We pray for the same Spirit to breathe into us and send us out as missionary disciples who carry the message of Jesus to others by our witness as a community of faith.

Ten days ago, the Archdiocese announced that it was lifting <u>all</u> COVID restrictions and leaving to each parish the decisions on how to proceed. Obviously, COVID is not "gone." People in our community continue to test positive; and those with compromised immune systems must continue to take extra precautions. After consulting with members of parish staff and leadership, I have decided that <u>at this point</u> we will not make any further changes to our procedures. The communion cups will return only when there is greater assurance that this will not present unnecessary risks to our ministers of communion or others; ministers of communion will continue to sanitize their hands before distributing the Eucharist. We continue to encourage anyone who is uncomfortable shaking hands at the Sign of Peace to place a hand over your heart as you face others and wish them peace. I welcome your comments as we discern the best response for this faith community.

Finally, the **Sunday 5PM Mass** will continue throughout the summer **with only** <u>two early</u> summer **exceptions: Memorial Day weekend and Father's Day**. We will celebrate the 5PM Mass on <u>all</u> <u>other Sundays</u> until Labor Day weekend. We welcome you to join us on Sunday evenings this summer.
