# Pastor's Letter

*Jesus said, "Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons.  
Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give."  
Matthew 10:8*

Jesus sends his disciples with a clear mission. We become missionary disciples when we take up this same mission. **What does it mean for us** to cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, and drive out demons? Perhaps the Spirit will bless some with the gifts to literally raise the dead. But how will the rest of us live out our mission this summer?

**We need a deeper understanding of the mission Jesus gives us.** Are we willing to be with *those who suffer physical or emotional illness* and let them know they are loved and remembered? Are we willing to invite *an isolated neighbor* to a backyard barbecue or block party? Are we willing to make friends with *those who fear being judged or rejected, or feel that they do not belong* among us "Catholics"? What are the "leprosy" of our day? And what are the demons that creep into our treatment of others? Are we willing to "change the subject" *when a conversation begins to belittle the human dignity of another*? Will we refuse to laugh at a *joke that comes at someone else's expense*?

**Will we be *missionary disciples* when opportunities present themselves this summer?**

Over the summer, we will say goodbye to one staff member and see another transition to a new staff position. We continue the search and hope to welcome **a new Business Manager** and **a new Youth Minister**. I am grateful to **Jennifer Zeisloft** as she moves into the new full-time position of Director of Stewardship and Development. And I give thanks for the gifts of **Jenette Teran**, who initiated a new direction for our high school youth program and brought us back into active participation in the Kairos Retreats and Summer Mission Trip in collaboration with St. John of the Cross and St. Cletus. God bless you, Jenette, on wherever the Spirit leads you. Visit us often.

**Happy Father's Day** to all who live the vocation of fatherhood as fathers, stepfathers, grandfathers, great grandfathers, godfathers, mentors, teachers, and coaches. ## Job Opening: Parish Business Manager

The Business Manager is a professional administrator who reports directly to the Pastor. This minister assists the Pastor with stewardship of the financial and personnel resources of the parish, working closely with the Facility Manager, School Principal, Accountant, other staff members and volunteer leadership in managing our parish strategically and responsibly.

Primary Responsibilities are in the areas of:

### 1) Financial Management

- Prepares and analyzes the annual budget, balance sheet and income statements for the parish and elementary school.
- Supervises the Parish Accountant in maintaining bookkeeping functions.
- Meets with the Parish Finance Council at least five times per year. Advises and informs the Council regarding current giving trends, upcoming capital and annual projects, operating income, cash-flow analysis, and other pertinent information necessary for the Council to provide insight and assistance in the financial strategies of the Parish.
- Supports the facility manager, especially with respect to large capital expenditures and Archdiocesan contracts.
- Advises the pastor and principal on contracts and negotiates with the assistance of Archdiocesan attorneys and facility resources.

### 2) Personnel Management

- Implements Archdiocesan human resource policies related to hiring and termination, annual staff evaluations, and benefit administration.

### 3) Administration

- Manages the workforce timekeeping and payroll systems with the Parish Accountant.

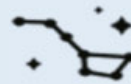

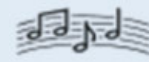

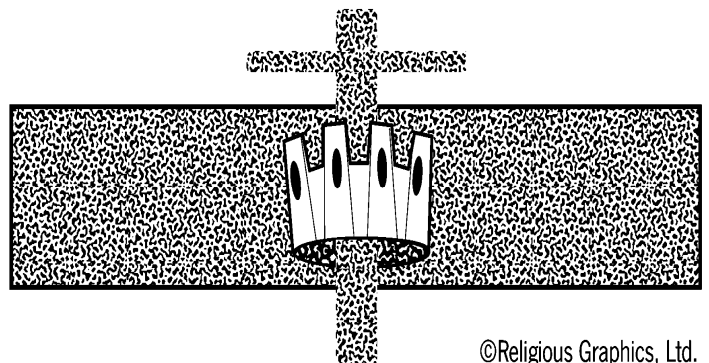

## Prayer Shawl Ministry in Partnership with Fisher House

The Fisher House Foundation builds comfort homes where military and veteran families can stay free of charge while a loved one is in the hospital. Currently 95 of these homes are located worldwide at military and VA medical centers.

We have one in the state of Illinois and it is located on the campus of Hines VA/Loyola Hospital in Maywood, Illinois. It was built in 2010 and has 20 suites with private bedrooms and baths. Families share a common kitchen, laundry facilities, a warm dining room and an inviting living room.

Our Prayer Shawl Ministry contacted the Fisher House Manager at Hines. Holly Wright was very enthusiastic with having a partnership and sharing our prayer shawls and lap blankets with our hospitalized veterans.

Rita Baumgart, Mary Freeman and I went to Fisher House and delivered 6 lap blankets and 4 prayer shawls on June 8th. We hope that when our supply allows, that we can continue to share prayer shawls and lap blankets with our hospitalized veterans.

**Our Prayer Shawl Ministry will have one meeting this summer on Wednesday, July 12th from 7:00 until 8:00 in Unity Hall.** Our mission is to provide comfort and strength with our prayer shawls and lap blankets to those within our community who need this support. With our new partnership with Fisher House, we would love to encourage more members of our St. Francis community to give thought to joining our ministry. Beginning skills in knitting and/or crocheting is required.

## BEWARE OF EMAIL SCAM USING PASTOR'S NAME

An email scam continues to use Fr. Bill's name as part of an email scam that is sent to random parishioners. This has been happening to pastors and ministers of other communities for several years. The pastor is listed as the sender with a fake (though sometimes credible) email address. An emergency request is made for money through the purchase of gift cards. If you respond, the sender asks you to reveal the PIN number on the gift card and return a picture of the card that includes the PIN. The scammer can use this information to redeem the gift cards.

**Fr. Bill and the parish staff will NEVER make a personal request for money in this way.** Requests for financial contributions to the parish or parish school will come via direct communication from the parish or school.
