#### Pastor's Letter

Jesus said, "Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons.

Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give."

Matthew 10:8

Jesus sends his disciples with a clear mission. We become missionary disciples when we take up this same mission. **What does it mean for <u>us</u>** to cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, and drive out demons? Perhaps the Spirit will bless some with the gifts to literally raise the dead. But how will the rest of us live out our mission this summer?

We need a deeper understanding of the mission Jesus gives us. Are we willing to be with those who suffer physical or emotional illness and let them know they are loved and remembered? Are we willing to invite an isolated neighbor to a backyard barbecue or block party? #### Job Opening: Parish Business Manager

The Business Manager is a professional administrator who reports directly to the Pastor. • Implements Archdiocesan human resource policies related to hiring and termination, annual staff evaluations, and benefit administration.

#### 3) Administration

 Manages the workforce timekeeping and payroll systems with the Parish Accountant.

## BEWARE OF EMAIL SCAM USING PASTOR'S NAME

An email scam continues to use Fr. Bill's <u>name</u> as part of an email scam that is sent to random parishioners. This has been happening to pastors and ministers of other communities for several years. The pastor is listed as the sender with a fake (though sometimes credible) email address. An emergency request is made for money through the purchase of gift cards. If you respond, the sender asks you to reveal the PIN number on the gift card and return a picture of the card that includes the PIN. The scammer can use this information to redeem the gift cards.

Fr. Bill and the parish staff will <u>NEVER</u> make a personal request for money in this way. Requests for financial contributions to the parish or parish school will come <u>via direct communication</u> from the parish or school.


