


SUMMER CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE

The photo of the roof surface demonstrates a location on the roof which was raised by 9 inches in order to create the slope needed for proper drainage. The architectural diagram shows materials needed to produce this slope and provide weather protection and insulation.


