

#### Pastor's Letter

"Whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that their works may be seen as done in God."

John 3:21

Missionary

Discipleship

Faith Formation It all begins in God's love for us. "God so loved the world that God gave God's only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." (John 3:15) Our salvation comes not from anything we did; it is a gift of God's love, offered at great cost to the Son of God, but without cost to us. St. Paul emphasizes this in his argument that we are saved by faith in what God has done for us and <u>not</u> by any of the works of our hands, however profound or noble they may be. Jesus has done the work; we receive the grace that we could never have "earned."

So, what does this mean for the fourth component of the life of the missionary disciple? If God has already done the work, what do we

accomplish through **MINISTRY**? Ministry is not about "earning" something from God; God freely gives us all that we need. Ministry is rather *our expression of gratitude* for what God has done for us and *our desire to reach out to others*, especially those in need, so that they may know what God has done for us <u>all</u>. In the words of St. Paul, "Faith without action is dead." Ministry is *our response to God's call* to use our talents to serve the church and all God's people.

Ministry is a grateful <u>response</u> to a call rather than something I do because I think I "should." It is unique to each person and lived out in a variety of ways. God may call me primarily to minister through my role in the family, especially in times when the family requires a large portion of my energy and focus. God may call me to engage in work for the good of the community, such as tutoring, coaching, or giving time to an organization that reaches beyond our local community to help those in need. God may invite me into one of the many parish ministries through which our worship, learning, and service bear fruit. God may call some among us to serve the Church as professional parish lay ministers, Catholic school teachers, religious, deacons, or priests. How do I discern what God is calling me to do? I pay attention to that which both gives me life and responds to a need that God has given me the talent to address.

This past Thursday, we gave thanks for the service of one who has ministered to our community for several years. **Sr. Marianne Race, CSJ**, has offered a weekly opportunity for scripture study to interested adults. She has inspired and led many among us to a deeper appreciation of the writings of our ancestors in faith. Her ministry has modeled for us the work of the missionary disciple. **Blessings to you, Sr. Marianne**, as you move on to new ministries and opportunities. We have not yet found someone to offer scripture study in the future, but we have many adults eager to learn. If you know of someone with the background, interest, and time to lead a scripture study group, encourage them to contact me or Maggie McMahon.

I invite you to seriously consider attending one of **two Area Reconciliation Services** on each of the next two Monday evenings: this **Monday at St. Cletus Parish** and **Monday, March 18, at St. Francis Xavier**. Lent offers an opportunity for spiritual house cleaning. I do not confess my sins to "get God to forgive me." *God forgives me when I sin: "Right away; no matter what!"* I confess *my need and desire for the grace of forgiveness* for my specific sins. I do not change God's heart; **God changes** <u>my</u> **heart.** That is the power of Christ crucified. The power of sin and death have been destroyed. God's love has conquered all.

The St Vincent de Paul Society (SVdP) is a lay Catholic organization that aspires to live the gospel message by serving Christ in the poor with love, respect, justice, hope and joy, and by working to shape a more just and compassionate society. Our SVdP Ministry assists parishioners and families and individuals in the LaGrange area when they encounter a financial hardship. In addition, SVdP meets with our clients to help them avoid a similar situation in the future by discussing their circumstances and directing them to resources in the community.

This past year, we assisted **17 families** with security deposits, property taxes, painting supplies, car insurance, cell phone bill, lodging, rent, and utility bills totaling **\$18,263**. Furthermore, we provide **\$1200** in food and gas gift cards to our Food Pantry clients and anyone in need who comes to our Rectory doors. We are grateful for your past contributions and hope you can continue to support our efforts.

The Feast of Mercy or Divine Mercy Sunday
has been celebrated in many countries,
dioceses and parishes for many years.
Pope John Paul II, the Cardinals,
Bishops and Priests
who have read the diary of St. Faustina have
come to appreciate the significance of this feast.
But now, ever since the Holy See had decreed
that the "Second Sunday of Easter would be
known as Divine Mercy Sunday,"
many more are seeking to go more
deeply into the words of
Our Lord to St. Faustina
that were meant for all humanity.

Pope John Paul II in his homily at the canonization of Sr. Faustina on April 30, 2000 said: "Jesus shows His hands and His side.
He points, that is, to the wounds of the Passion, especially the wound in His Heart, the source from which flows the great wave of mercy poured out on humanity".

The image of Jesus, The Divine Mercy, is to have a special place of honor on the Feast of Mercy, a visual reminder of all that Jesus did for us through His Passion, Death, and Resurrection...and a reminder, too, of what He asks of us in return—to trust Him and be merciful to others.

The Eucharist is the "Fountain of Life".

The Eucharist is Jesus, Himself, the Living God, longing to pour Himself as Mercy into our hearts.




