

Total Collected during Last Fiscal Year: \$ 1,761,074
Total Annual Offertory Budget: \$ 1,846,000

Our fiscal year has ended. On behalf of all the parish staff, THANK YOU for your amazing generosity in helping us reach our Christmas and our Easter budgets, as well as your response to our appeal for an increase in regular Sunday offertory. In combination, total offertory increased about \$60,000 (3.4%) over last year. The business office is working on finalizing the parish's operating results. We will have a full report for you in the annual report, which is expected to be published in October.

\$20,000 Raised for Building Projects!

Each year, the SFX Catholic Women's Club hosts events to raise funds for the benefit of the parish, including the School of Religious Education, the elementary school, and capital projects to maintain our campus facilities.
