



## Ministry of Care is Planning to Expand

A Minister of Care is a person who brings the gift of the eucharist and friendship to fellow parishioners and others who are homebound, living in nursing homes, or recovering in the hospital. Our visits help those in need stay connected to the parish and our faith community.

It's a very rewarding ministry and I promise you will receive more than you'll give.

The time required varies depending on the activity you choose. Perhaps a few minutes or more on a homebound visit to an hour or so conducting a Prayer and Communion Service or bringing the eucharist to those in the hospital. Those visiting the homebound schedule visits convenient for the minister and the person being visited. Nursing homes and the hospital have fixed schedules.

The Archdiocese requires new ministers to receive 12 hours of instruction prior to being commissioned. After training, you will "shadow" other ministers to learn about your chosen activity. When you are comfortable, you'll receive a quarterly schedule.

One day training is available at LaGrange Hospital. Saturday, September 6th from 8:30am-4:00pm. Lunch provided.

#### We are in the midst of a historical time in the Church...and SFX is a part of it!

For the past 2.5 years, SFX has been partnering with Discerning Deacons, Catholic Theological Union and women all over the country and world to bear witness to the critical and urgent need to re-think women's participation in the Church. SFX has held several listening sessions on this issue. We have learned about St Phoebe who was a deacon in the early church and have worked to restore her memory.

Pope Francis convened a 3 year Synod to LISTEN to the people of God from all over the World. The Synod ended last October and study groups have been formed to examine key issues. One of those issues is the role of women and their vocation to participate fully in the life of the Church (paragraph 60 of the Synod Document)

"we know that the door to the discernment about women deacons is decidedly not closed. This is something worth celebrating! But it comes with great responsibility, because it asks us to be the ones to grow the conversation" (Discerning Deacons)


#### Fall Scripture Study Begins September 11! Thursdays at 9:30am in Unity Hall






