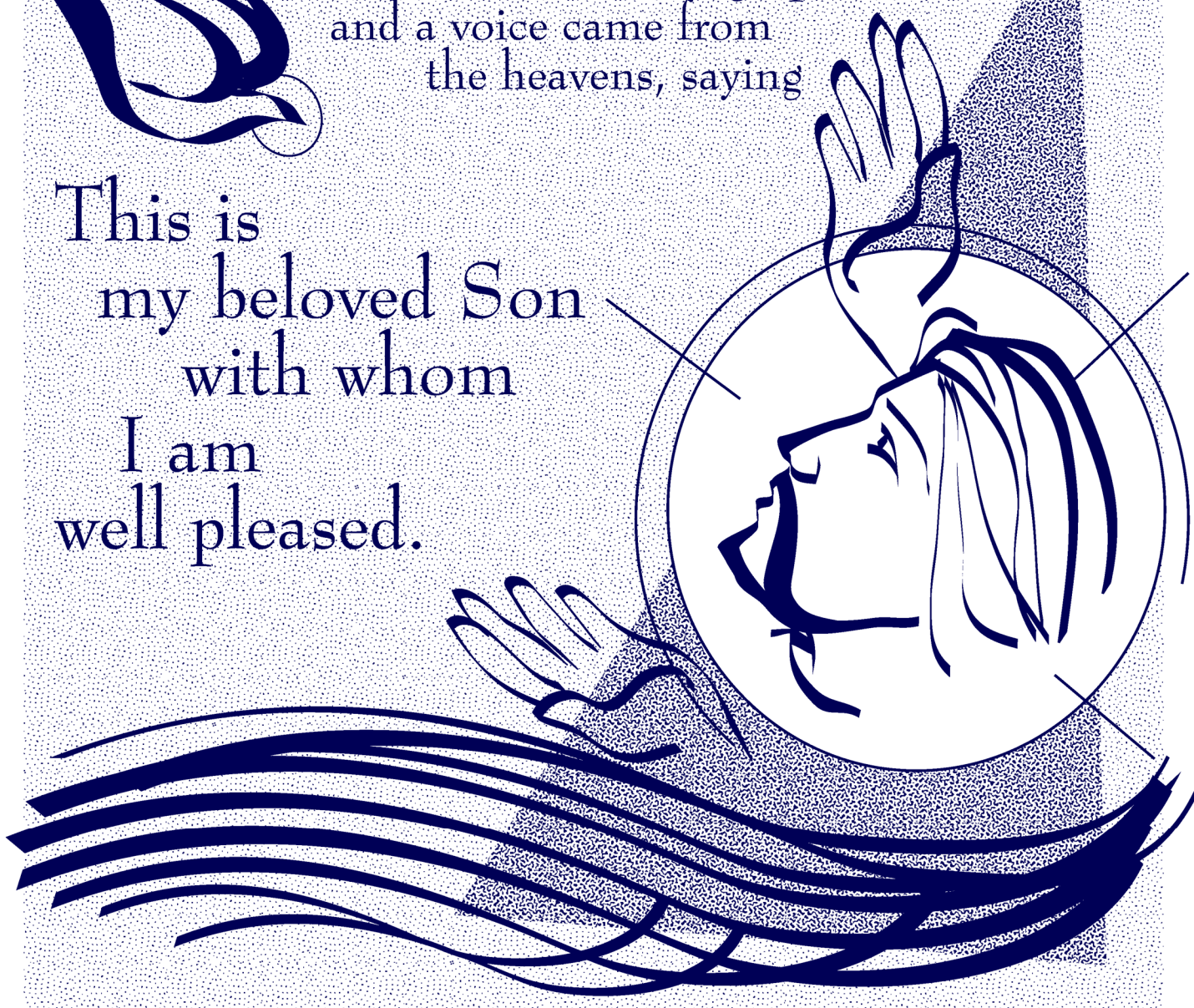

Pastor's Notes

Come to the water. It happened in those days that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized in the Jordan by John.

Isaiah 55:1, Mark 7:9

Jesus begins his mission on earth through water and the Spirit. Each of us enters into our mission with Jesus in much the same way. Jesus did not need a baptism for the remission of his sins; nonetheless, he seeks out John's baptism at the Jordan River when he senses it is time for him to proclaim the kingdom of God in word and deed. And just as we are named as a child of God in our baptism, so Jesus hears the Father's voice proclaiming him as God's beloved Son. And so, his mission begins.

On your behalf, I thank the many people who have provided us with a beautiful Christmas season in a year that challenged us to be creative and committed. Our Art and Environment team, coordinated by Celine Heraty, gave us a new way to experience the manger scene and brought new beauty to the church and our two other worship sites. Allen Sterwalt worked within COVID protocols to ensure that the Gloria of the Christmas angels echoed out from our worship in voice and instrument, including those of Jeremy Michor and a slimmed-down Spirit Choir. Frank Roccasalva and our facilities team provided needed support, including the extra efforts to clear the snow, salt the walks, and mop the church on key days. Jennifer Zeisloft coordinated our livestreams and recordings and collaborated with our social media intern and photographer Brian Lipchik to provide a montage of photos to remember this Christmas at <https://vimeo.com/495352067>.

We enter a new year of our mission in Christ: to wholeheartedly live and celebrate the Gospel of Jesus Christ; to commit ourselves to live in

communion with God, others, and all of creation to create a more just world through sacraments and worship, learning and service. We are supported by the ministry and prayers of those who have come before us and the desire to be a place of welcome and challenge for those yet to join us. May we continue to become God's instrument to those who thirst, those without money, and those who seek the Lord.

You may have heard by now that I was struck by a car on New Year's evening as I was crossing a street in downtown LaGrange. I give thanks to God that my injuries are relatively minor under the circumstances, including a dislocated shoulder and broken nose. However, I have had to accept that the immobilization of my left arm and the need for rest have placed some limits on what I am able to do. I am grateful to those in the car, who stayed with me while we waited for help to arrive; the LaGrange police officers and paramedics who tended to me at the scene, and the staff in the Emergency Room at Advocate LaGrange Hospital, who took great care of me and endured my moans and my sense of humor. Most of all, I am grateful to God for never leaving my side.

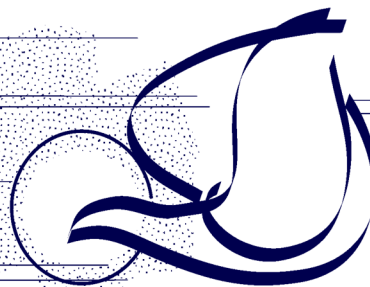

DIGGING A WELL IN AFRICA

Last summer, a parishioner offered to make a very generous contribution toward half of the cost of constructing a well in a sub-Saharan African village to bring fresh water to the community. Many of you met this challenge, and Bishop Eduardo Hiiboro Kussala of the Diocese of Tombura-Yambio expressed his gratitude for the generosity of so many. This solar operated well will serve over 1,000 villagers at a construction cost \$34,000.

We recently learned that unrest in the part of Africa in which the well was to be built has put the project on hold until peace can be restored to the area. Every new crisis in areas such as this results in more suffering, more uncertainties, and more disruptions in daily life and plans. Please keep the people of this part of the world in your prayers this Christmas Season. We will keep you informed as more news becomes available.

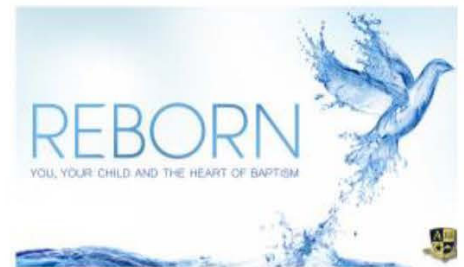
