



# **Scripture Reflection**

How important is it for us to have a friend, a life partner, a spouse? A friend can be there to urge us on when the going is tough, to celebrate our victories and accomplishments with us. A Friend is someone in whom we can take joy by celebrating their well-being. And when a friend suffers, we too suffer. A friendship is a gift of God.

Jesus too recognizes how important it is to have a partner. He sends the Twelve out two-by-two. These disciples are not lone wolves; they are not renegade rangers. They travel with one another for mutual support, which will likely form a bond of friendship if it were not there already.

Being called to be in a relationship with Jesus is to be also in a relationship with other disciples. None of us is on this path alone, and thank God for that. The Christian life can never be a "Jesus and me" relationship. It always, and by necessity, involves other Christians, if not other people altogether.

Even the Twelve, chosen by name to be with Jesus in a more intimate relationship with him and one another, are not sole actors. They travel together two-by-two.

Who are my partners? Who travels with me two-by-two? This might be a good day to thank God and thank my partner.



# The LaGrange Area Ministerium

For more than 30 years, clergy members lay leaders from various faith communities in and around LaGrange have gathered monthly to share resources and address current issues. St. Francis Xavier Church is one of approximately 20 faith communities involved.

Most recently, members of the Ministerium have been working to provide a just wage to low income workers, the option of pre-school education for all children, housing for the homeless, support for low income residents in an assisted living facility under less than adequate management, and a summer Community Peace Camp for children ages 4-14.

Annual prayer opportunities, which often feature music by a combined choir, include: a Thanksgiving Community Service in November, a Good Friday Community Service prior to



Easter, and the "All Together Under the Son" in August (morning prayer to kick off the Sunday of "Endless Summerfest"). The Thanksgiving and Good Friday services have been hosted for many years. The "All Together Under the Son" service began in 2016, following the wonderful success of the SFX 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Outdoor Mass a year earlier.

Fiscal Year Report of Collections from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 Total Collections for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018: \$1,823,346

Our total collections for the fiscal year that ended on June 30<sup>th</sup> decreased about \$10,700 from the previous fiscal year and were about \$75,000 below what we had budgeted. In the upcoming months we will provide more information about how this affects our financial position.

We are in the process of revising our budget for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, which began July 1<sup>st</sup>. Until this has been finalized and reviewed by the Finance Council in early September, we will not be reporting actual collections versus budget.

The success of the campaign allows us to continue our investment in our campus this summer of 2018. Check out our progress thus far...

Below: The gym vestibule and restrooms are halfway done. For those who are used to the boys bathroom on the south end and the girls on the north end, be prepared for a switch! The girls bathroom required more square footage, so we swapped genders for the bathrooms to minimize the reduction to our storage areas. Also depicted is the before view from the accessible seating area in the vestibule (within the two knee walls).

Opposite Page: The demolition, excavating and cement trades have been busy transforming our parking lot and new plaza area. We are also investigating support structures for when our Air Conditioning Tower is replaced and assessing our existing power set-up.




Open view of Gym from accessible viewing area

Mark Burrows, Ph.D. author of Meister Eckhart's Book of the Heart: Practicing Wholeness in a Time of Fragmentation on Saturday, August 4 from 9:00 am-3:30 pm. "The eye with which I see God is exactly the same eye with which God sees me. My eye and God's eye are one eye, one seeing, one knowledge, one love." This is pure Eckhart, and one could say of such a claim that it is about all one needs to know. The



challenge is putting it into practice. This retreat, based on the recently published book of the same title, will be an opportunity to do just this: to drink deeply from the wellspring of Eckhart's vision, and allow it to shape-shift our lives into more creative and audacious forms of faithfulness. Bold, courageous, and sometimes outrageous, his language continues to be a guiding beacon of light to those seeking to live more authentically, faithfully, freely. During this day-long retreat, we will explore Eckhart with help from a new book of the same name (written by the presenter Mark Burrows, with his colleague Jon Sweeney).

Mark Burrows is well-known internationally for his writings and as a lecturer and retreat leader. A published poet with a doctorate in historical theology, he has devoted his life as teacher and scholar to exploring the intersection of theology, spirituality, and the arts. Poetry and mysticism are his passion, "among the most practical and life-changing sources one can find," he says. *Cost: \$75 includes lunch.*
